The US Coast Guard (USCG) is the administrator of the Aids to Navigation System (AToN), a program designed to assist the prudent mariner in the process of navigation.

When Panasonic engineers met with the USCG, they discussed the harsh realities of working in a saltwater environment.

Panasonic provided the USCG with a mobile computing solution capable of performing in these conditions by making design changes to the Panasonic Toughbook 28. The modifications included sea air-resistant paint, anti-corrosive grease for moving parts and airtight inserts for the DC plug.

The USCG then put the unit through vigorous tests to ensure the Toughbooks were up to the challenge. Not only did the Toughbook pass all tests as a result of the new, state-of-the-art design, but it has since become the standard mobile PC for the USCG.


