- For solid detergents difficult to dissolve in water quickly, such as laundry pods, please fill them in the drum. Filling them into the detergent drawer directly may cause water leakage.
- Please service the auto dispensing compartment regularly.
 - Every three months
 - When it is necessary to change the brands of liquid detergents or softeners
 - If liquid detergents or softeners stay in the auto dispensing compartment more than one month
 - When the auto dispensing compartment is not refilled within one week after the display prompts insufficiency
 - When liquids in the compartment are gelatinous

- Actual water temperature may differ from the declared cycle temperature.
- The test results depend on water pressure, water hardness, water inlet temperature, room temperature, type and amount of load, degree of soiling, utilized detergent, fluctuations in the main electricity supply and chosen additional options.

WVT: For normally soiled laundry at the rated capacity, we recommend using the “Cotton, Cold” which is tested in accordance with TCVN 8526 for the energy efficiency aspects.

WMY: For normally soiled laundry at the rated capacity, we recommend using the “Cotton, 60 °C” which is tested in accordance with MS IEC60456 for the energy and water efficiency aspects.

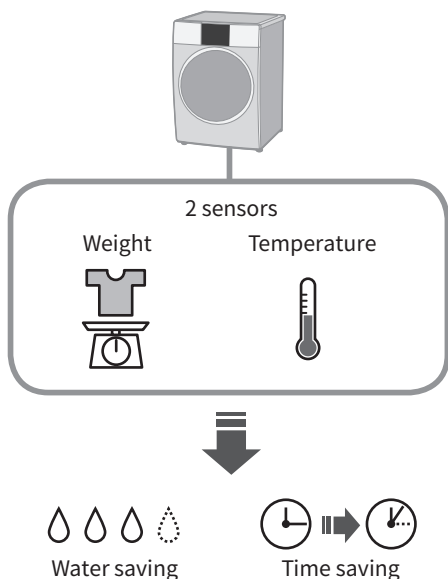
