





Disconnect the USB plug when cleaning the main body with water.

Fully insert the power plug of the adaptors securely.

AC adaptor, self-cleaning recharger, USB power adaptor and USB cable:

Do not immerse them in water or wash with water.

Do not place them over or near water filled sink or bathtub.

Never use the appliance if they are damaged or if the power plug fits loosely in a household outlet.



Do not damage them.

- Do not deface, modify, forcefully bend or pull them. Also, do not place anything heavy on, twist or pinch them.





Handling of the removed battery when disposing

ADANGER

- The rechargeable battery is exclusively for use with this appliance. Do not use the battery with other products.
- Do not charge the battery after it has been removed from the product.
- Do not throw into fire or apply heat.
- •Do not hit, disassemble, modify, or puncture with a nail.



- Do not let the positive and negative terminals of the battery get in contact with each other through metallic objects.
- Do not carry or store the battery together with metallic jewellery such as necklaces and hairpins.
- Do not use or leave the battery where it will be exposed to high temperatures, such as under direct sunlight or near other sources of heat.




After removing the rechargeable battery, do not keep it within reach of children and infants.

Important information

 This WET/DRY shaver can be used for wet shaving using shaving lather or for dry shaving. You can use this watertight shaver in the shower and clean with water. The following symbol means suitable for use in a bath or shower.



- Treat yourself to wet lather shaves for at least three weeks and notice the difference. Your Panasonic WET/DRY shaver requires a little time to get used to because your skin and beard need about a month to adjust to any new shaving method.
- If you clean the shaver with water, do not use salt water or hot water. Do not soak the shaver in water for a long period of time.
- The following symbol indicates that a specific detachable power supply unit is required for connecting the electrical appliance to the supply mains. The type reference of power supply unit is marked near the symbol.

- Charge the appliance correctly according to these Operating Instructions. (See page 10 "Charging the shaver".)
- This appliance contains battery that is only replaceable by skilled persons. Please contact an authorized service centre for the details of repair.
- Do not recharge non-rechargeable batteries.


Note the following precautions in order to prevent malfunction, deformation and deterioration

- · Do not drop or hit against other objects.
- Do not bring the system outer foil into contact with hard objects.
- Do not leave the shaver exposed to direct sunlight with the foil frame detached.
- Do not dry the main unit with a dryer.
- Be sure to place the protective cap on the shaver when carrying around or storing.
- Store the shaver in a place with low humidity after use.
- Do not leave the detergent in location of high temperatures.
- Immediately wipe up any cleaning liquid that has been spilt.

This symbol on the product means that not generated higher voltage than the safety extra low voltage (SELV). In which protection against electric shock relies on power supply.







There may be water droplets inside the self-cleaning recharger at the time of purchase, but there is no problem regarding the hygiene. They are remains after the factory inspection.

Preparation

Charging the shaver

- Turn the shaver off.
- Wipe and dry any water droplets or facial cleanser on the main body rear terminals or the appliance socket.




Charging with the self-cleaning recharger

- Do not use the self-cleaning recharger while charging the shaver via the USB cable, as charging will not occur.
- 1 Insert the appliance plug into the self-cleaning recharger.
- 2 Remove the protective cap 2 while pressing the side of the cap and insert the shaver into the self-cleaning recharger.




- Slowly insert the shaver into the self-cleaning recharger taking care not to damage the system outer foil.
- 3 Plug the adaptor into a household outlet.
 - Check that the charge status lamp (→) is glowing.
 - Charging is completed after approx. 1 hour.

Disconnect the adaptor after charging is completed.



The charge status lamp (→) glows.

The battery capacity lamp will blink in order while the charging progresses.




The charge status lamp (→) turns off.

Charging using the USB cable

- Use the specified USB power adaptor and USB cable.
- The USB power adaptor is sold separately.
- Open the socket cover and insert the USB plug firmly into the main body and USB power adaptor.
- 2 Insert the USB power adaptor firmly into a household outlet.
 - Check that the charge status lamp (→) is glowing.
 - Charging is completed after approx. 2 hours.
- 3 Remove the USB power adaptor from the household outlet, and remove the USB plug from the main body after the charge status lamp (→) turns off.
 - · Close the socket cover.

Note

You cannot operate the shaver while charging.



Notes

 The shaver may be charged with adaptors and cables other than the specified ones, but Panasonic's specified adaptor with splash-resistant design and a USB cable with an overheating protection function should be used to ensure safety.

The adaptor is not completely waterproof, so prevent it from getting wet.


- When charging the shaver for the first time or when it has not been in use for more than 6 months, the charging time may change or the charge status lamp (⇒) may not glow for a few minutes. It will eventually glow if kept connected.
- Recommended ambient temperature for charging is 10 °C − 35 °C. Charging may take longer, or the charge status lamp (→) will blink quickly, indicating that the battery is not charging properly in extremely high or low temperatures.
- The shaver can be used for approximately 2 weeks with a full charge.
 (Based on one 3-minute dry-shave usage per day in an ambient temperature range of 20 °C 30 °C.)
 The number of usable days varies depending on the following conditions.
- Beard thickness
- -Pressure applied to the skin
- Usage frequency of the shaving foam mode or wet shaving.
- If there is noise from the radio or other sources while using or charging the appliance, move to a different location to use the appliance.

Preparing the cleaning liquid

Cleaning can start right after the usage by preparing in advance.


• Remove the AC adaptor from the self-cleaning recharger.

1 Press the cleaning liquid unit removal button (1) and remove the cleaning liquid unit (2) on a hard, horizontal surface.




 When the self-cleaning recharger is lifted, or on the soft surface such as carpets, the lock release lever will not fit in the recharger properly. In that case, the cleaning liquid unit cannot be removed.


2 Pour tap water (1) and detergent (2) into the cleaning liquid unit.



 Pour the entire packet of detergent.



Slowly insert the cleaning liquid unit into the self-cleaning recharger until it clicks.



Notes

- To replace the cleaning liquid, see page 19.
- Only use self-cleaning recharger detergent for Panasonic shavers.

Not doing so may cause malfunction or failure.

- Do not tilt the self-cleaning recharger.
 Doing so may cause spill or the number of days that cleaning liquid can be used reduce.
- You can use the cleaning liquid for approximately 30 days if used once per day.
 (This will differ depending on beard thickness and the ambient temperature.)

How to use

Making foam in shaving foam mode

It is easier to make foam this way than by hand.

► Usable facial cleansers, etc.

- · Do not use anything other than above listed shaving agent/facial cleanser/body soap etc. as these may cause the blades to clog, or be unable to make foam.
- Check that the socket cover is closed.

Preparing foam

Scoop a suitable amount of facial cleanser or similar in your hand, and add a suitable amount of cold or warm water.

- Hold (10) for 2 seconds or more to switch to shaving foam mode.
 - The battery capacity lamps blink in order.
 - The shaving foam mode ends after 15 seconds. The shaver can then be used to shave.
 - To stop using the shaving foam mode and start shaving, press the power switch once.
- 3 Press the blades gently in the palm of your hand, mix the facial cleanser etc. around and move the blades up and down to make foam.
 - If there is insufficient foam, add slightly more water, hot water or facial cleanser etc. to make it easier to create foam.

► Notes

• Do not use shaving agent (excluding foam), facial cleansing foam (with scrubbing compounds) or soap as these may cause the blades to clog, or be unable to make foam.





Shaving beard

 Check the system outer foil for cracks or deformations before use.

1 Press ① and shave.

 The "shaving sensor", which automatically adjusts the power depending on the beard thickness, will operate.

The shaver adjusts its power, delivering high performance on areas with dense beard growth and reducing power on areas with lighter growth, minimizing strain on the skin.



Tips for better shaving

Apply the whole system outer foil perpendicularly against the skin and shave by slowly gliding the shaver over the face against the grain of the beard.

- The beard under the chin and around the throat can be shaved better by stretching the skin so the beard will stand.
- To prevent damaging the system outer foil, do not shave with only a part of the system outer foil.





2 Press when finished.

When the battery capacity is low

The appliance beeps after switched off.

 You can shave 2 to 3 times after the charge status lamp (→) blinks. (This will differ depending on usage.)

Notes

- The appliance may not operate in an ambient temperature lower than approximately 5 °C.
- The shaving sensor may not respond depending on the type and quantity of the shaving gel. This is not abnormal.
- To prevent erroneous operation, place your fingers on the finger rest while using the shaver.

▶ Using the trimmer

- Slide the trimmer handle up to the "m" position so that the trimmer stands upright.
- 2. Press (10) and use.




Press and hold the top knob (a) and slide the trimmer handle down to lower the trimmer.



Tips for better usage

Apply the trimmer edge perpendicular to skin gently and move downward slowly.

Trimming sideburns







► Switching the shaver head

You can change the pivot action.



The shaver head is moved to prevent missed spots.




- 1. Press ① once and then release.

 - The switch lock lamp (♠) will turn off after 5 seconds.



► Unlocking the power switch

- 1. Hold ① for more than 2 seconds.
 - The shaver starts operating.
- 2. Release ①.

Cleaning, drying, charging

We recommend cleaning the shaver after each use.

- Do not use the self-cleaning recharger while the shaver is being charged through the USB cable.
- 1 Insert the shaver into the self-cleaning recharger and plug the adaptor into a household outlet. (See page 10.)
 - When the LOW lamp or the STATUS lamp lights up, see page 20.



2 Press SELECT.

The CLEAN lamp and the DRY lamp glow, and the "AUTO" mode will start after approximately 6 seconds.

 It is not possible to change the mode after the "AUTO" mode has started.



*When the ambient temperature of the self-cleaning recharger is low (approx. 15 °C or lower), the drying process will take up to 170 min.

3 Remove the adaptor after the selected mode is completed.


Clean the shaver with water or with the cleaning brush once per month. (See pages 16 to 18.)



The main unit neck section ((a)), trimmer, system outer foil gaps, etc. cannot be cleaned with the self-cleaning recharger.

Changing the mode of self-cleaning recharger

The "Charge" mode starts when attaching the shaver, and the mode can be changed by pressing the SELECT button.



Notes

- Do not press the cleaning liquid unit removal button during cleaning as the cleaning liquid may spill causing a malfunction.
- The drying time may increase in an ambient temperature approximately 15 °C or lower.
- The Clean or Dry function may not operate under extreme low temperatures (approximately 0 °C or lower).
- A lubricant constituent is included in the detergent, so smooth shave is maintained without applying oil.

Cleaning thoroughly

Cleaning with water


- The self-cleaning recharger cannot be washed with water.
- Turn the shaver off and disconnect the USB plug.
- · Check that the socket cover is closed.

1 Apply some hand soap and some water to the system outer foil.

2 Press ① and make foam for several seconds, then press ① to stop making foam.



- 3 Remove the outer foil section and clean with running water.
 - See page 18 for removing the outer foil section.
 - After rinsing with water, shake the shaver up and down for a few times to remove excess moisture and then wipe off any drops of water with a dry cloth.
- 4 Attach the outer foil section and dry with the self-cleaning recharger.
 - Insert the shaver into the self-cleaning recharger and plug the adaptor into a household outlet.



2. Press (SELECT) twice.

The DRY lamp glows, and the "Dry/Charge" mode will start after approximately 6 seconds.

 It is possible to change to the "AUTO" mode even after the "Dry/Charge" mode has started.





Remove the adaptor after the selected mode is completed.

5 Lubricate the shaver.

It will keep the movement of the blades smooth and maintain a comfort shave.



- Apply one drop of oil to each of the system outer foils.
- 2. Raise the trimmer and apply a drop of oil.
- Switch the shaver on, and run it for approximately five seconds.
- Switch off the shaver, and wipe off any excess oil from the system outer foil with a soft cloth.

▶ Drying the shaver without the self-cleaning recharger

Dry in a shade and apply oil.



Notes

- Do not use any kitchen or bathroom detergents other than hand soap.
- Doing so may cause malfunction.
- Be careful not to hit the main body on the sink or any other object while draining the water. Failure to do so may cause malfunction.
- Do not wipe with thinners, benzine, alcohol etc.
 Doing so may cause malfunction, cracking or discoloration of the parts.
- Wipe with diluted soapy water.
- Do not use the self-cleaning recharger while droplets or soap remain on the shaver.
- Doing so may change the concentration level or composition of the cleaning liquid in the cleaning liquid unit, which may degrade cleaning, sterilization, lubrication and drying performance. This may also cause cleaning liquid to spill from the self-cleaning recharger.

Cleaning with the brush

Remove the outer foil section. (See this page.)

Clean the system outer foil in the areas indicated by the circles every time you use the shaver. Otherwise, abnormal sound may be generated.



► Cleaning with the long brush

Clean the foil frame, system outer foil, the main body and the trimmer using the long brush.



Replacing the system outer foil

 glows once every 18 months. (Based on one 3-minute shave use per day)

We recommend checking the system outer foil when it appears.

 Press the power switch for more than 30 seconds to reset the cumulative usage duration and make blink.

system outer foil	Approximately once every
	18 months*

- * The replacement timing is a recommendation and is subject to individual usage and preference.
- ► Removing the outer foil section
 Press the foil frame release buttons and lift the outer foil section upwards.



► Attaching the outer foil section

After turning the foil frame mark (\nearrow) to the front, securely attach the outer foil section to the shaver until it clicks.



► Replacing the system outer foil

- Press the system outer foil release buttons and pull down the system outer foil.
 - Do not press the system outer foil release buttons with excessive force.



- Doing so may bend the system outer foil, preventing complete attachment to the foil frame.
- 2. Align the foil frame mark (∠) and the system outer foil mark (△) and securely attach together until it clicks.

Note

Do not throw away the foil frame.

Replacing the cleaning liquid


If the STATUS lamp glows for 5 seconds when the SELECT button is pressed, the cleaning liquid needs to be replaced.

- Even if the STATUS lamp does not light up, replace the cleaning liquid after 6 months have passed.
- 1 Remove the AC adaptor and remove the cleaning liquid unit. (See page 12.)
- 2 Wash away the old cleaning liquid.
 - It can be drained as sewage.



- Pour water as illustrated while tilting the cleaning liquid unit and shaking it gently.
- You can clean with the cup divider removed.

After washing, be sure to attach the cup divider.





- parts of the cleaning tray with a cotton swab dampened with water.
- 5 Prepare the new cleaning liquid. (See page 12.)



The symbol on the left means "Do not wash the self-cleaning recharger with water".

Notes

- The cleaning liquid will decrease every time it is used, but do not add detergent and water except when replacing the cleaning liquid.
- Doing so may deteriorate the cleaning function.
- Do not wash the self-cleaning recharger unit with water.



 Do not wipe with thinners, benzine, alcohol etc.
 Doing so may cause malfunction, or cracking or discoloration of the parts.
 Wipe with diluted soapy water.

► When the water does not drain from the cleaning tray

- Do not tilt the self-cleaning recharger to pour out water. Doing so may cause the cleaning liquid in the cleaning liquid unit to spill or cause the self-cleaning recharger to malfunction.
- Beard trimmings may clog the drain at the bottom of the cleaning tray.
 In this case, you cannot clean or dry the shaver.



- 1. Be sure to remove the AC adaptor from the self-cleaning recharger.
- Place the self-cleaning recharger on a flat surface, and push the beard trimmings down through the drain (b) with a toothpick etc.

When the LOW/STATUS lamp glows

It indicates that the cleaning liquid is due for replacement when the LOW lamp or STATUS lamp glows for approximately 5 seconds when the SELECT button is pressed.

Lamp on the selfcleaning recharger

Content of notification

Replacement of the cleaning liquid is required in approximately 7 days. Prepare the detergent.

Replace the cleaning liquid.
(Modes other than the
"AUTO" mode can be used
even if it is not replaced.)

If you think the replacement should not be due yet.

- Is the cleaning liquid unit correctly attached?
- Is the self-cleaning recharger placed in a level
 surface?

The battery will deteriorate if not used for over 6 months. so make sure to perform a full charge at least once every 6 months.

Answer

The battery used is a lithium-ion, so charging after every use will have no effect on battery life.

Continuing to charge the battery will not affect battery ▶ performance, but disconnect the adaptor for safety and to save energy.

Detergent: Non-ionic surfactant agent, antimicrobial agent, lubricant and fragrance.

Oil: Liquid paraffin

The sound indicates that the battery capacity is running low. Please charge the appliance.



- Take care not to short circuit the positive and negative terminals of the removed battery, and insulate the terminals by applying tape to them.
