#### Bleach



# **Troubleshooting**



	Symptoms	Points to be checked
	Water is supplied while washing.	When water level drops.  When amount of laundry is large.  Water is added automatically.
Wash	The water level too high	When laundry is wet.  When there is water in the tub before operation.
	too low	When clothes are light (synthetic fibre, etc.).  The water level may be higher.
Rinse	Operation started with rinse, but water is not supplied.	When there is no water in the tub.  Water is supplied after spin.  When there is water in the tub.  Water is supplied after water discharge and spin.
Spin	Spin changes to rinse.  Rinse starts instead of spin.	If clothes are uneven, this appliances automatically corrects unevenness by rinse process.
	Irregular rotation	The tub rotation speed is adjusted to reduce vibration.
