


Electrical work




Where to install

- If the product is used or stored in a hot spring or coastal area, it may be damaged (due to sulfur or salt).
- If the product is used in a very cold or freezing location it may be damaged.

If you intent to install the product in any of the above areas or locations, consult with the supplier or dealer where you purchased the product.

Installation

■ This is a product installed and used indoors. Install on a flat place providing suitable support, and take measures to prevent overturning.



Clear the area around the product by at least 10cm for waste heat dispersal and ventilation.


Keep the product away from:

- Rainwater, a sink, or excessive humidity;
- Outdoor
- Direct sunlight, or excessive heat (e.g. oven, stove)
- Excessive dust Metal powder or corrosive gases.

Instructions for earthing

Make sure the earthing work has been done correctly before use.

For a socket with an earth terminal.



Installation

- Make sure to earth the electrical connection for safe use of the product.
- Never earth to a lighting conductor, gas piping, water piping, telephone line, or another earth wire.
- For any questions, contact the supplier or dealer where you purchased the product or a licensed service provider.

Caution for the exemption of liability for an accident or damage (fault).

We are not liable for accidents or damage if used by a method not described in the operating manual or installed without using the designated parts.

Operating temperature and temperature range.

Use this product at an outdoor temperature range between 5 and 35°C. Use 60% humidity or less.

If out of this range, cooling may be inefficient, or condensation may form inside, outside, or on the articles.

Operation

Introduction

- Use the plug supplied with the product.
 Use the electric cord supplied.
- Remove packaging materials and tapes, and then leave the product for a while for ventilation.



Single-phase socket with earth terminal

- Accessories are kept inside the product. Check if anything is missing (Refer to Page 8).
- The product is cleaned before packing. However, cleaning before use is recommended.

Operation


- Install the bottom rack and the basket correctly.
- Operate a test run before merchandise are stored. It starts cooling after 10 minutes. Operate for approx. 2 hours after power on, and use it after confirming that the interior has cooled.


Instructions for use

■ This product adopts an air cooling system. Do not fill the freezer's interior with water.

How to use the basket and the bottom rack

- Use the basket and bottom rack as shown in the below illustrations.
- Quantity of basket and bottom rack are showing page 8.





How to place merchandise in the product)

- Do not put or throw merchandise exceeding 20 kg into the basket.
- Surely store pre frozen merchandise.
- Practices first in, first out rotation to ensure the quality of merchandise.
- Store merchandise below the load line.
- Arrange merchandise in each basket uniformly.

A CAUTION

Do not display merchandise above the load line.



This may prevent adequate cooling and cause an article quality loss.


Re-start

- Leave the product for at least 5 minutes before re-starting.
- If the product is re-started immediately after switching off, the overload protection unit or a wiring breaker may trip, or an excessive load may be applied to the compressor, which will result in failure.


Temperature adjustment

Adjust the internal temperature with the temperature adjustment knob on the front side of the product (Refer to Page 7). Internal temperature varies depending on the ambient conditions such as external temperature or humidity. Adjust by turning the knob clockwise if need more cool or counterclockwise if need more warm.




Lamp indicator

Compressor operating lamp-It illuminates while the compressor is operating.



Power lamp — It illuminates when the power is on.

- How to LOCK/OPEN the key.
- 1. Need to push before turn the key.
- 2. Insert the key while the cover is closed
 - It locks when turned to the right.
 - It releases when turned to the left.



Operation

About defrost

- Defrost by the following procedure when frosting of the freezer reaches 5mm.
 - ① There is a drain outlet at the bottom of the product. Place a water collector under the outlet.
 - ② Remove all articles from the freezer and disconnect the power plug from the socket.
 - 3 Remove the drain cock inside the unit and drain the melted water.
 - 4 When drained, wipe the interior thoroughly with a dry cloth and replace the drain cock.

⚠ CAUTION

Do not remove frost with a hammer, knife, or hottle.



The inner box (cool area) may be Prohibited damaged, preventing cooling and the articles may thaw out.

How to checkup and service

↑ WARNING

When servicing, ensure to disconnect the power plug from the socket.



Failure may cause an electric shock or injury from a moving part.

Disconnect the power plug

Do not spray water directly onto inside or outside of the product, or wash it.



This may cause an electric shock or fire due to a short circuit.

Strictly no water.

Do not touch the plug with a wet hand.



It may cause an electric shock.

Wet hands are prohibited.

How to checkup and service

Outside and inside the product

- Service periodically in order to keep clean.
- Wipe with a soft, dry cloth.

 If very dirty, wipe with a damp cloth after applying a little neutral detergent.

 Do not use an alkali or acid detergent, acid, oil, thinner, benzene, alcohol, polishing powder, powdered detergent, hot water, or a scrubbing brush since these may damage the painted or plastic surfaces.

For a recommended neutral detergent, follow the instructions indicated on the container.

Condenser

Clean once each half year

⚠ CAUTION

Burn injury or other injuries may result.




Prohibited

Do not clean with bare hands.




 Do not touch the condenser's fins directly.

- Make sure to stop the operation and clean it after the condenser has cooled.
- Ensure to wear thick gloves.
- Remove any dust and dirt adhering to the condenser with a brush.
- Avoid any damage to the condenser's fins. Remove dust with a brush by brushing up and down.



How to checkup and service

■ SF-PC697, SCR-P697, SF-PC997, SCR-P997 and SF-PC1497, SCR-P1497 Remove dirt or dust from the condenser at the rear of the product.



Note: For the model which use skin condenser, condenser cleaning is not required.

How to checkup and service

How to clean the power plug

Conduct periodically

Disconnect the power plug, and remove dust and dirt from the terminals.

Remove dust and dirt from the power cord too.

Wait 5 minutes before reconnecting the power cord after the cleaning.



Note: The power plug shown in the picture may be difference from the actual plug of product. Depend on the local standard.

Attention

Dust or dirt may accumulate within a short period depending on the installation location or use.

Please check this when cleaning.

Please check

Please check following to ensure safety after cleaning.

- Is the power plug inserted firmly into a dedicated socket? Is there any abnormal heating?
- Are there any cracks, scuffs, or damage by mice on the power cord? For any question, contact the dealer where purchased or the Customer Service Dept.

How to checkup and service

Cleaning the machine room

Service periodically (1 or 2 years' interval)

- If dust has accumulated in the machine room, the freezer may not cool efficiently due to the reduced heat radiation effect. Damp dust may cause a power leakage.
- Ask the supplier or dealer for machine room cleaning service.

Warning

Do not clean the machine room by yourself.



Do not clean since it is dangerous.

Lamp cover

Replacement of the interior lamp

An interior lamp is fitted only in model SF-PC1497, SCR-P1497.

How to change Lamp.

- ① Disconnect the power plug from the wall outlet.
- ② Notice the Mark point, have to shown in the normal position (figure 1).
- 3 Turn the Lamp cover to counter-clockwise, until the mark point on liner align with mark point on the lamp cover. (figure 2), and pull the lamp cover from the liner.
- 4 Turn the Lamp from the socket.
- ⑤ Change lamp

Specification of Lamp: 240V 15W / Dimension: 13mm

(a) Install the Lamp cover, do the opposite procedure. (Figure 3 and Figure 4)



Safety Precautions

In case of a power blackout

- Please minimize opening and closing the door.
- Do not add any items. They may increase the internal temperature.
- Fill the freezer with dry ice in case of a preannounced lengthy power outage.

When not using the product for a long time

- Remove all items from the product, and remove the plug from the power socket.
- Clean inside the product, and wipe away any moisture throughly.
- Open the door and dry the interior to prevent the growth of mold or odor.

If the unit is not in use temporarily or in storage

- Be careful not to store in a place where children may play.

 If a young child is locked in, the door cannot be opened by himself.
- Secure the door with tape or rope after inserting a piece of wood in order to prevent opening and closing the door.

When you move the product

- Remove the plug from the power socket.
- Move after draining completely.
- Be careful not to damage the cord with the adjusting bolt or castor while moving the product.
- Be careful not to damage any step or threshold with the adjusting bolt or castor.
- Use a dolly when moving the product to a remote place.
- Do not tilt the product. It may fall over.

When servicing, ensure to disconnect the power plug from the socket.
