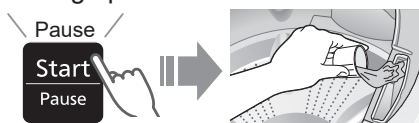
- If powder detergent does not dissolve well, mix and dilute powder in a cup of warm water and put into the liquid detergent / bleach inlet.



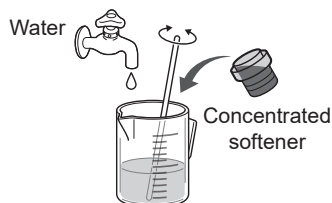

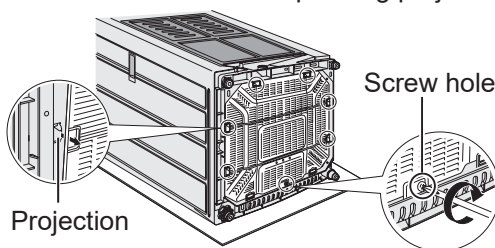
Attach the bottom cover

Preparation: Set a cardboard, etc. and lay the washing machine on it, avoiding product damage and deformation. (Face the front side down)

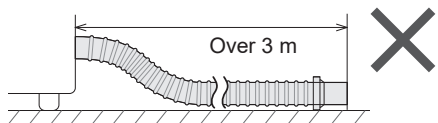
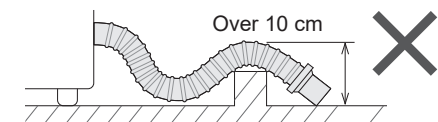
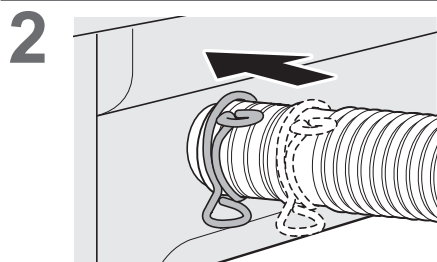
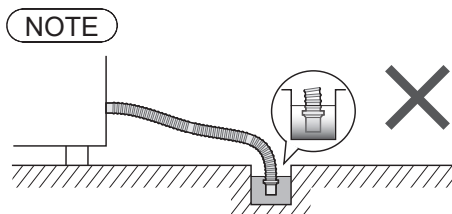
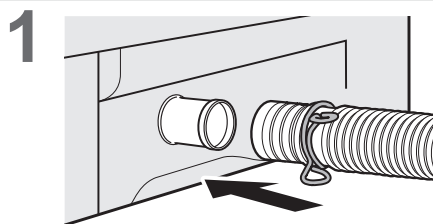

- 2 Set 6 holes to the corresponding projections and fix with one screw.



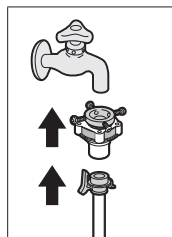
