



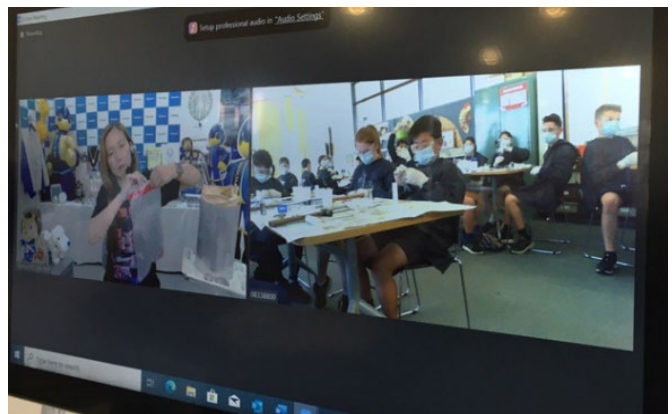
Panasonic Battery Making Activity - G6 LOTE Japanese 22nd & 23rd August 2022
